Note that these words were chosen to make sure that every conceivable cursive joining stroke is represented at least once. Other words were added to make sure that all 44 English speech sounds and their major spelling patterns were included, making the program good review of essential spelling patterns. For example, the first word is coded 1-1 (1) be. The first 1 is the number of the group and the second 1 is the number of the card in that group. The number in parenthesis (1) is the consecutive number in the whole program.

Thanks to Randy Nelson of Peterson Directed Handwriting for providing me with a comprehensive list of connecting strokes and pointing out the advantages of direct instruction over trace and copy. Dr. Bob Rose encouraged me to teach student the alphabet in alphabetical order so they can develop fluency writing the alphabet from A to Z from the start.
